Houston St. / Williamsburg Br.) or Exit 8 (E. 34<sup>th</sup> St. / Midtown Tun.). For southbound access to FDR Drive, please use the E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street or E. Houston Street on-ramps. Traffic on FDR Drive will be maintained at all times.
