Limited Road Closures at Jackson St. and South St.

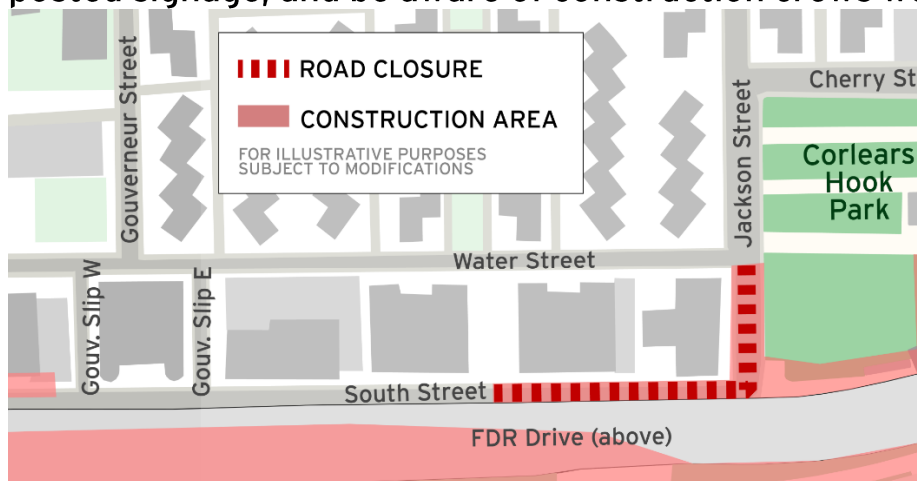
- Jackson Street, from Water Street to South Street
- South Street, from Jackson St. to FDR Drive Exit 3 Ramp

Starting Tuesday, May 27th, 2025

24 hours/day, 7 days/week

Expected to last approximately 1 week.

This temporary restriction is necessary to facilitate road restoration work along South St. Please be advised that vehicles exiting the FDR Southbound via Exit 3 ramp to South St. will continue to have access; however, the South St. lane will be partially occupied due to ongoing construction activities. Drivers should proceed with caution, follow all posted signage, and be aware of construction crews working in the area.
