

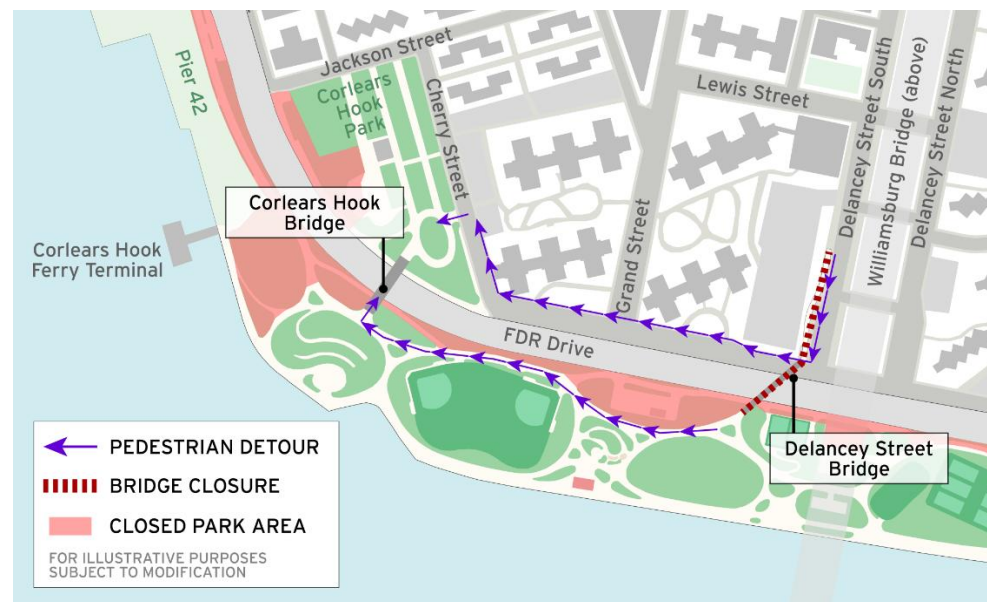

# Temporary Closure of Delancey Street Bridge

Monday, January 5<sup>th</sup> through  
Friday, January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026

A temporary closure of the Delancey Street Bridge will be in place for approximately one week to accommodate the installation of the permanent railing for the bridge ramp and staircase. Pedestrians may access and exit East River Park using the Corlears Hook Bridge at Cherry Street. Noise and air quality monitors are in place. For your safety, please follow all posted signs and directions from safety personnel. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience as conduct these upgrades.
