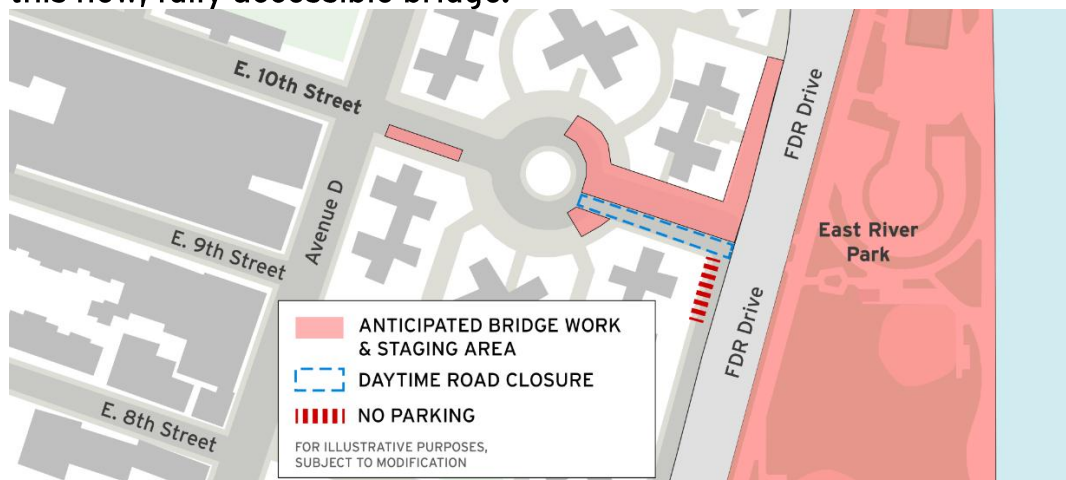

E. 10th St. Bridge: Mobilization and Pile Installation

Beginning the week of June 8th, 2026
7:00 am to 4:00 pm
Ongoing for approximately 3 months

To facilitate construction of the new E. 10th Street Bridge, mobilization of equipment will begin east of Avenue D on E. 10th Street. **Installation of piles will begin soon after and is expected to be a noisy and disruptive operation.** To ensure the safety of the community, this work requires parking limitations and road closures, including access to the FDR Drive Service Road from E. 10th Street during work hours. Noise, vibration, and air quality monitors are in place. Thank you for your patience as we install this new, fully accessible bridge.
