Construction of Ballfields 1 and 2, including lighting foundation installation. Nature exploration mockup assembly. Curb for Shared Use Path adjacent to M&O area. Weekend work and extended weekday working hours anticipated.

Micro-tunneling activities begin in E. 10 th Street Shared Use Path Area of East River Park, see Advisory . FDR NB right lane closure.

4	03/29/24–04/13/24	7:00 am to 3:30 pm	Montgomery Street / South Street area and Various Locations:	Ongoing micropile installation and jet grouting Montgomery St. parking lot sidewalk closed for floodwall construction, see Advisory
5	03/29/24–04/13/24	7:00 am to 6:00 pm	East River Park Greenway & FDR Dr. between Montgomery St. & Jackson St.:	Ongoing sheet pile installation and Con Edison utility abatement work. FDR Dr. NB Montgomery St. on-ramp shifted onto East River Greenway, see Advisory .

7	03/29/24–04/13/24	7:00 am to 5:00 pm	FDR Drive Service Road between Grand Street and Delancey Street Pedestrian Bridge:	Utility work, curb, sidewalk, test pits, fence relocation and pier construction. Sidewalk at FDR Dr. service road- pedestrian access reopened, see Advisory .
