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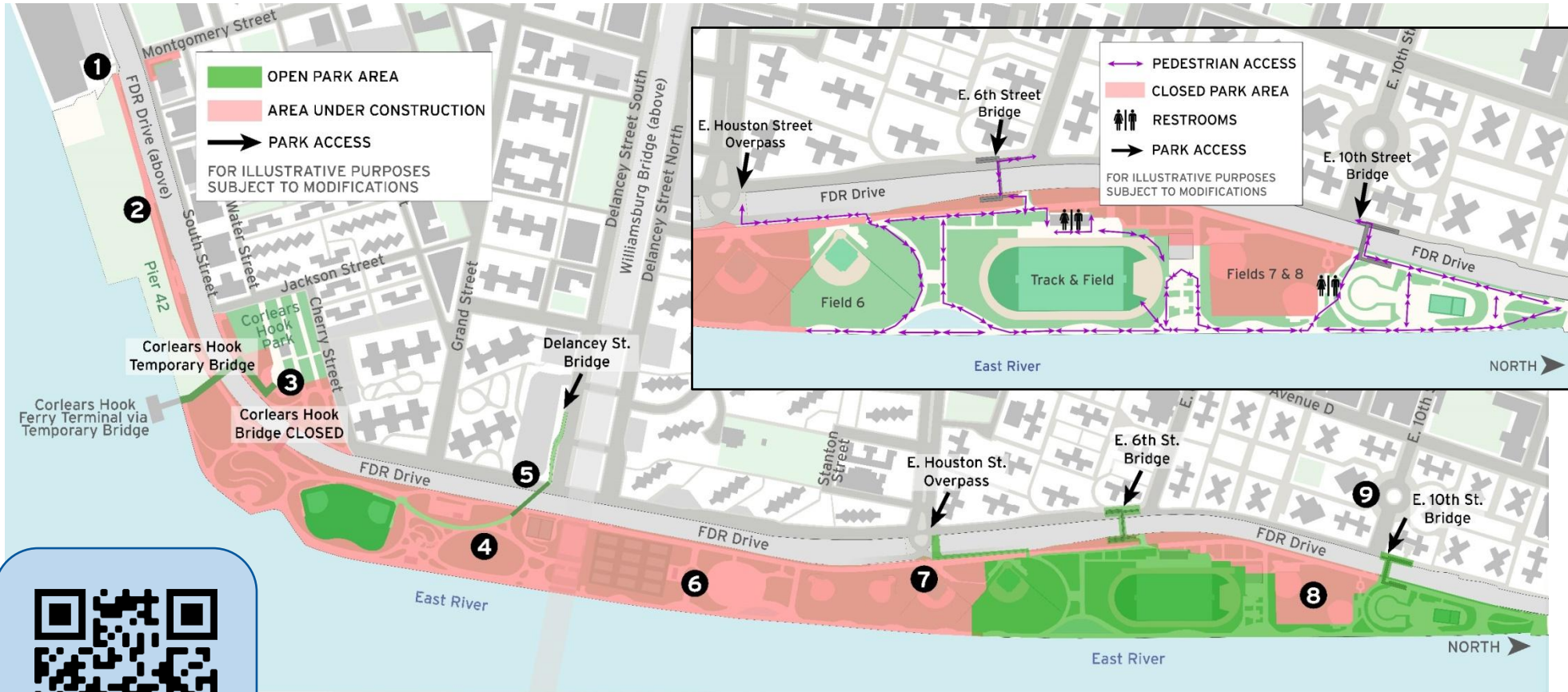
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The contractor may extend work hours and/or occur on weekends when necessary, as approved by NYC DDC.
