Week 2: Remove & Install sewer manhole and 12" watermain – No service interruption anticipated by the watermain work. <b>Night work will continue for at least the next 4 weeks.</b>
3	03/08/21-03/19/21  03/15/21-03/19/21	7:00 am to 3:30 pm	E 23rd Street underneath the FDR Dr.	*Change in Traffic Pattern will continue under the FDR Dr.* - <b>Flaggers and Traffic Enforcement Agents are on site to assist pedestrians and keep traffic flowing.</b> Utility work ongoing in preparation for flood wall installation. Sewer manhole and 24" sewer installation in progress. Week 2: Backfill and temporary pavement.
