BECOMING A BUILDING AUTOMATION INTERNSHIP SITE

Henry Street Settlement can connect you with fully funded interns.

YOU'LL RECEIVE:

- A young adult intern (age 18 to 24) trained by Stacks+Joules with skills in lighting controls, basic Python coding, EPA 608 refrigerant handling, basic wiring and electrical knowledge, and construction certification OSHA30+SST
- An intern paid for by New York City for up to 150 hours (up to 29 hours per week for 5 to 10 weeks)
- A temporary team member eager to get hands-on experience
- Job candidates who have a growth mindset; are resilient, professional, and collaborative; and have a passion for sustainability and clean energy
- Worker's compensation insurance coverage provided through the New York City Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD)
- Henry Street Settlement support for completing the worksite application, troubleshooting during the internship process, and completing DYCD documentation

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU:

- To provide a job description and complete a worksite application with clear expectations and goals
- Mentorship, open feedback, and communication, ensuring a young adult is prepared to obtain a full-time job in the infrastructure industry
- Opportunities for skills development
- A welcoming environment and culture
- Networking and professional exposure, including career advice
- Job description and completion of the worksite application (estimated half-hour) with clear expectations and goals
- Access for the internship coordinator to conduct a mandatory Site Safety Pre-Assessment
- Access for the internship coordinator to conduct biweekly in-person check-ins with interns and the supervisor
- Completion of a performance assessment form
