Workforce1 partners with four (4) training organizations that offer pre-apprenticeships with direct entry to the unionized construction industry. The first step to enroll in a pre-apprenticeship is to attend an information session.

Requirements

- Over 18 years of age
- NYC resident
- High School Diploma/Equivalency¹
- Valid ID & Social Security Card
- Interested in a career in the Construction Trades
- Willing to commit to an apprenticeship program that can last up to 4 years
- Able to attend unpaid training during the day Monday through Friday. Training is mostly provided virtually or remotely and some in-person attendance is required.
- Computer, tablet, or mobile device for participation in virtual/remote training
- Some programs require a Test for Adult Basic Education (TABE)²

¹ Foreign Diplomas are allowed for entry into training but only considered by Unions on a case by case basis

² For those pre-apprenticeship training programs that require a TABE test, applicants generally need at least an 8th Grade Reading & Math Comprehension score on their TABE Test
