- 2. A valuable resource for information about the hiring and training process.
- 3. Guidance from a positive role model.
- 4. Ongoing support through the challenges you may face.

When will this program take place?

The Firefighter Candidate Mentorship Program will span throughout your time at CPAT training and, should you be appointed, through your time at the Fire Academy.
