



The U.S. Mint has discontinued pennies and Department of Finance business centers no longer have any to give as change.

Customers can still pay with pennies. For cash transactions, we will round change up to the nearest nickel.

How DOF's rounding works:

Ends in	Rounded to
\$0.05	Exact change given
\$0.01 - \$0.04	\$0.05
\$0.06 - \$0.09	\$0.10

For example, if a customer's total is \$49.96 and they pay with a \$100 bill, they will receive \$50.05 in change. If a customer's total is \$43.39 and they pay with a \$50 bill, they will receive \$6.65 in change.

Electronic transactions and in-person credit card transactions are not affected.
