FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

Use this application to request a correction to a property assessment or real property tax due to a clerical error or an error in description by the Department of Finance.

Who can file an application to correct an assessment or property tax due to a clerical error or error in description?

Only the owner of the property or other persons who are eligible to file an application with the Tax Commission, as specified in Title 21, Section 3-02(b) of the Rules of the City of New York, can file an application for correction of an erroneous assessment or tax.

What types of errors are eligible for correction?

Clerical errors and errors in description as defined in Title 19, Section 53-02 of the Rules of the City of New York are eligible for correction. Visit www.nyc.gov/finance for more information.

How far back will errors be corrected?

The Department of Finance will only correct eligible errors that occurred during the tax year in which an application for correction of errors was submitted, the two directly preceding tax years, or any combination of such tax years, except for extenuating circumstances as defined by rule.

What's the application deadline?

Applications will be accepted and reviewed on an ongoing basis.
