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Your landlord has started a court case against you for the nonpayment of rent. Come to the Landlord & Tenant Clerk's Office in the Civil Court right away to answer the landlord's papers. If you didn't get any papers, bring this card.

**Important!** If you don't come to court, you may be evicted.
