NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON 2022 QUALIFIED ALLOCATION PLAN
LOW INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDITS

Pursuant to Section 42 of the Internal Revenue Code and under the authority of New York State Executive Order 11, the City of New York, through its Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), hereby announces a public hearing on the City's 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan (the "Plan") for allocating federal low-income housing tax credits to eligible rental housing projects located in the City of New York.
