

HPD-NYSERDA \$15 Million Future Housing Initiative for New Construction Initiative Pre-Approval Letter

Background: The Future Housing Initiative will provide owners and developers up to \$10,000 per dwelling unit (Base + Boost) and up to \$1.5 million per project to fund the construction of high-performance All-Electric* multifamily buildings that will achieve Passive House Certification. Phase One of the Future Housing Initiative will be open to projects in HPD's New Construction Pipeline that are projected to close within 1-2 years of application to the program and can meet the program's performance goals. Note that projects that are not likely to meet the program's required timeline will be eligible for Phase Two.

Projects are required to submit this letter as part of the application process to confirm that the project is eligible and meets the Future Housing Eligibility Requirements.

- Applicants are highly encouraged to request this Letter from Program by May 15th.
- Applications are due by June 1st, 2023.
