
THE CON EDISON LOAD LETTER: ENSURING THAT YOUR PROJECT CAN ELECTRIFY!

As soon as the MEP completes the load calculations, the load letter process can and should be initiated IMMEDIATELY. This reduces the risk that new service will not be available. Con Edison needs about 20 days to evaluate and confirm available service capacity.

- The MEP consultant, the GC or the owner can initiate the process in the permit application portal. Simply use your own name and input a made-up license number in order to advance to the next screen.
- If something changes in the design and once an electrician of record is on board, Con Edison can re-rule the job later under the electrician's license.
- Once the Load Letter is accepted, submit a copy to the Pilot Technical Assistance Provider (TAP)

At minimum, project teams should submit <u>AT LEAST one month before project closing</u>, but to confirm that service will be available for the project, the sooner this is submitted the better.
