

Notice of Intent to Sell- Change of Ownership Request

Owners of properties with any HPD assisted tenants should notify HPD of their intent to sell the assisted properties at least 30 days in advance of the anticipated closing date or when a contract for sale has been executed. This requirement for advance notice includes any transaction that transfers ownership of the property from one entity to another, even though the individuals or the corporations may be similar or related.

HPD is required to review the eligibility of the proposed purchaser to enter into a Housing Assistance Payment (HAP) contract and if determined eligible, assign the HAP contract once the sale is complete. HPD may deny approval to assign the Housing Assistance Payment (HAP) contract if the buyer is disqualified for any reason listed under Section 13(f) of the HAP contract, which can be found online at: https://www.hud.gov/program_offices/administration/hudclips/forms/hud5a or HPD's Administrative Plan.
