Child Care information now available for Cash Assistance cases

Appointment Description Updates

- Appointment descriptions have been updated to provide clients the most current information regarding the steps they should be taking during the COVID-19 pandemic to complete their benefit applications and recertifications. These updates include the following:
 - Updated SNAP Recertification instructions for IVRS clients
 - Updated instructions for Cash Assistance 6-Month Mailer/Mail-In Recertification
 - Information for Cash Assistance clients who have received a notice of intent to close for failure to submit the CA recertification form (G70) or complete the CA recertification interview (G69)
 - Information regarding what phone number you will receive a call from to complete your SNAP or Cash Assistance application interview
