- Connect to Your HRA Case A user who provides identifying information through ACCESS NYC will be able to form a link to HRA's case management system for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (also known as Food Stamps) and Cash Assistance. This will establish an HRA online account, allowing clients to view case information and make updates to their contact information online, for the first time.
- Cash Assistance Application and Recertification If a user is currently receiving Cash
 Assistance benefits and needs to recertify, they will now be able to submit their application to
 recertify on ACCESS NYC. For clients applying for on-going cash assistance (which includes
 SNAP and Medicaid), emergency grant/one-shot deal or child care grant (CILCOA), the online
 application will be available on ACCESS NYC at select HRA centers, and rolling out to
 additional HRA centers.
- My Cases Once a user has created an HRA online account, the user will have the ability to
 view details related to their SNAP or Cash Assistance cases such as EBT balances, case status,
 required appointments, required eligibility documentation, payments to landlords or utility
 companies, case composition, request a budget letter, make updates to contact preferences
 as well as sign-up for text & email alerts.
- **My Documents** Once a user has created an HRA online account, the user will have the ability to view which documents HRA has on file for their SNAP or Cash Assistance cases.
- **User Home messaging** ACCESS NYC will remind clients when they have a saved application to submit, when they submitted their online application and when a SNAP or Cash Assistance recertification is coming due among other features.
