


Child Support Makes a Difference

3 Simple Ways To Get Child Support Services

Option 1: Easiest | Apply Online



- Step 1: Complete the <u>New York State Online Enrollment</u> form.
 - connects to child support account, if you already have one, or create one to get started.

Step 2: A Child Support representative will contact you regarding the next steps.



Option 2: Download a child support enrollment form or request one



Step 1: Go to <u>nyc.gov/hra/ocss</u> and navigate to the section on how to apply for services. Download the enrollment form.

Step 2: Once completed, email it to <u>dcse.cseweb@dfa.state.ny.us</u>. You can also hand it in at any of our offices or mail it to: OCSS, PO Box 830, Canal Street Station, New York, NY 10013



Option 3: Submit a child support petition directly to Family Court

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Step 1: Download and complete a court petition at https://bit.ly/3mGSfzC.

Step 2: File the petition at the Family Court in your Borough.

During the court hearing you can request that child support payments be made via the Office of Child Support Services (OCSS) also referred to as the Support Collection Unit (SCU).
