More than 3,000 noncustodial parents have participated in a Pay It Off (PIO) program to reduce \$16 million of debt owed to the NYC Department of Social Services (DSS). The average debt reduction per case is \$5,558.

Step 2	Make a payment(s)		
	 Make a payment of \$500 or more intended for Pay It Off between October 17-31. Payments must be received no later than October 31, 2022 to receive the credit and the total amount of your court ordered current support obligation that is due in the month of October must be paid first and will not be matched. Payments should accompany the agreement. When submitting the agreement separately, indicate when and how the payment will be submitted. For multiple cases, submit a separate payment per case. Make payments payable to the "NYS Child Support Processing Center". Include case I.D. and indicate "Pay It Off" on your payment. 		
Step 3	Get your qualified payment dollar-for-dollar match		
	OCSS will send you a summary of action taken 4 to 5 weeks after the agreement and payment are received.
