



RESIDENTIAL EVICTION PETITIONS FILED IN HOUSING COURT, CY20-24





Given the reduction in non-payment filings in CY24, warrants issued and evictions conducted may decrease in future years as this cohort of cases moves through the court process.




EMERGENCY ORDERS TO SHOW CAUSE FILED, CY20-24



PRETRIAL MOTIONS FILED, CY20-24


