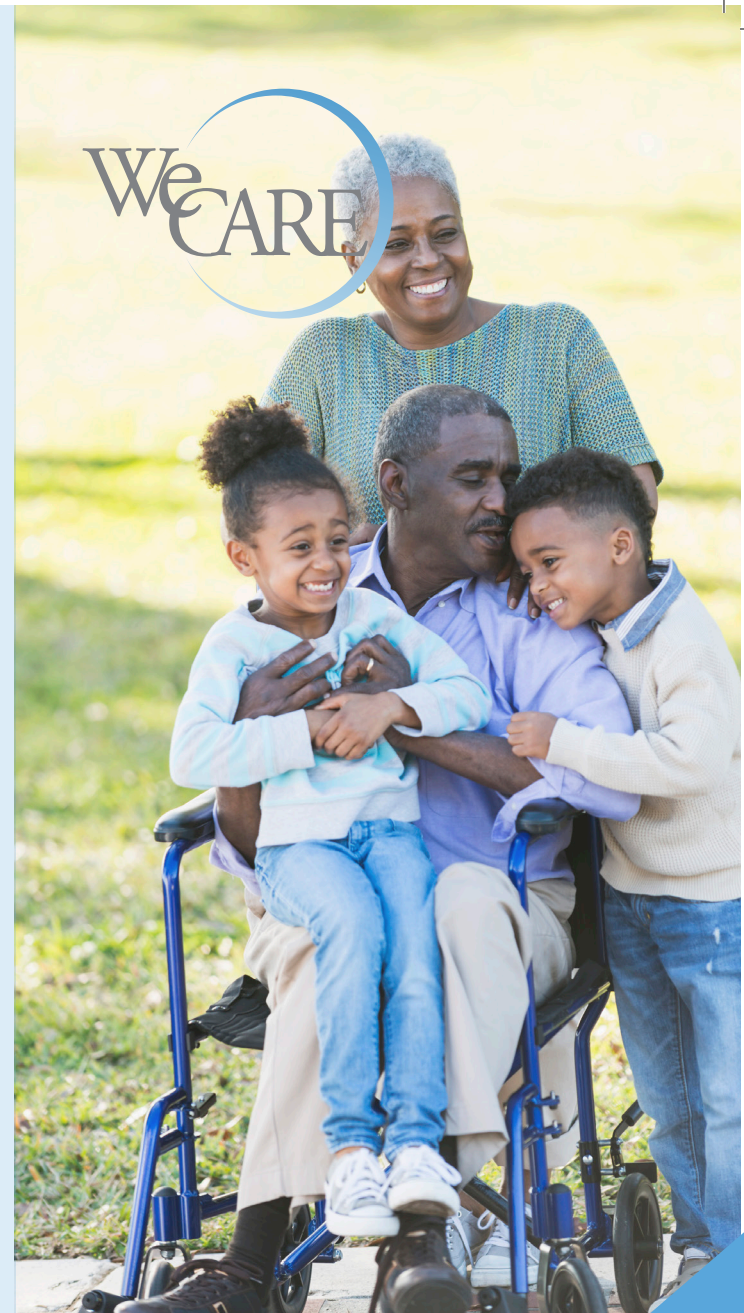

5 Steps Towards a Greater Well-Being

You will receive an assessment to identify medical or other issues that may affect your ability to participate in work-related activities.

2

Based on a comprehensive assessment, we will work with you to develop a customized plan to meet your needs.

3

Depending on your plan, you may:

- » Obtain treatment to improve your health conditions and progress toward wellness;
- » Be given specialized employment services including a work setting that accommodates your limitations;
- » Receive assistance in applying for disability benefits for which you may be eligible.

To help you be successful, we will work with you to monitor your progress.

Once you get a job, we will make sure you get the support you need to keep it, while continuing to help you reach your potential.
