















Labor Force Participation Rate*






Professional and Managerial Occupations (%)



Immigrants by Race and Ethnicity NYC, 2019






Immigrants by Race and Ethnicity NYC, 2015-2019

Poverty Rate*










Integration Characteristics

Mean Number of Years in U.S. (%)






