What can I do if my friend or family member is detained or facing deportation?



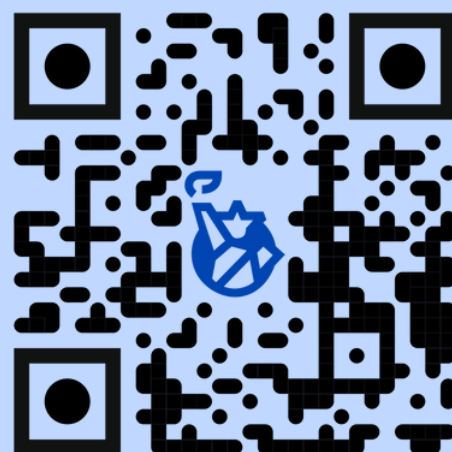
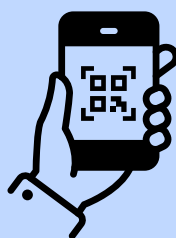
If your friend or family member:

- was told they cannot speak to an immigration judge
- or is facing a fast-track to removal
