





#### **Current Activities**


- Pre-construction survey

#### Coordination


- Portions of the esplanade are closed for EDC construction work



### **BMCR | Esplanade Access & Greenway Realignment**

#### **ALL WORK IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE**

- New Greenway alignment will go into effect the within the next few weeks and remain in effect until end of construction (2026)
- Path alignment was planned in coordination with NYC DOT
- Signs advising bikes to yield to pedestrians posted along shared zone
- Furnishings along waterfront removed to ensure 10 ft minimum width
- Amenities north of Market Slip are currently accessible, but contractor expects to begin fencing off these areas for construction beginning Summer 2023—with at least two-weeks notice
- Subject to change as construction activities progress
