Temporary Esplanade Width Reduction

From Market Slip to Pike Slip

Starting December 3, 2025, for up to eight (8) weeks

Ahead of final restoration, an extension of the fenced-in work zone under the FDR Drive is required to accommodate construction of the permanent base for future amenities. This will result in a narrower path along the esplanade between Market Slip and Pike Slip. Please follow all posted signs and flaggers.
