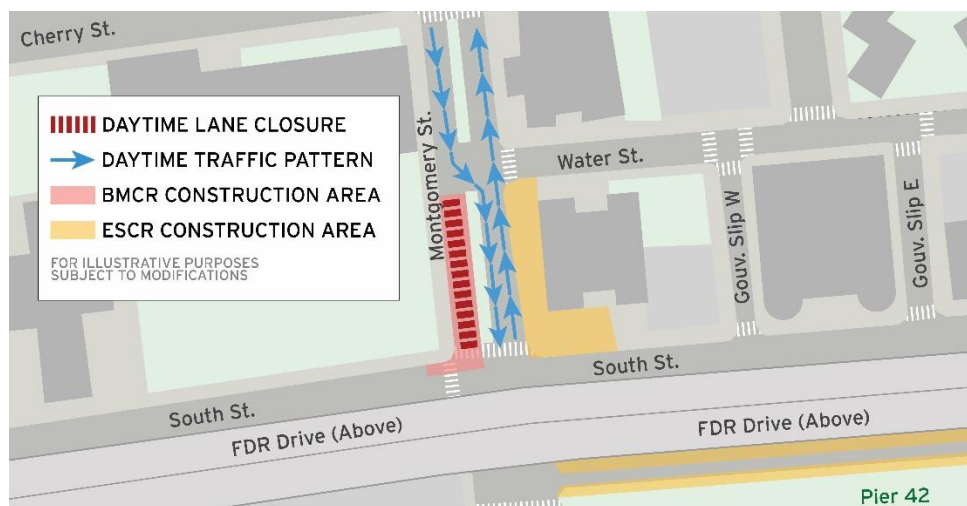
## Daytime Parking Restrictions and Traffic Shift on Montgomery St., from South St. to Water St.

Utility work in the intersection of South St. and Montgomery St. requires daytime closures of Montgomery St. and two-way alternating traffic in the north lane. Pedestrian access available on the south side of Montgomery St. Bicyclists must share the road. For your safety, please follow on-site signage and flaggers. Normal traffic pattern will resume after work hours.
