



353 West 20th Street

No. 353 was built in a style transitional from Greek Revival to Italianate for John Waters in 1852-3. The original cast Iron railings at the stoop and areaway are ornamented versions of the typical elongated Italianate design and are in excellent condition. The replacement of the present door with double doors, appropriate to the style, would enhance this building and strengthen its original elements - the cornice and part of the door enframement.














mock up views from playground on 21st street *location of mock up outlined in red dashed box
