



DISTRICT RESEARCH

I surveyed a 4x8 block area around my building, 613 Hudson Street, roughly one quadrant of the District. I limited my selection to small, older buildings like my own. I further focused on code compliant guardrails and ignored the historical, non-complying railings.

2 types exist - vertical pickets and horizontal cables.

- a. Pickets are much more common than cables.
- b. Most pickets appear to be $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " square-profile stock. Thicker and curved examples also exist.
- c. Most are painted black. Gray and silver were also observed.
- d. Many picket railings are set at the roof edge.




ENLARGED ILLUSTRATION OF PROPOSED GUARDRAIL




 $\frac{3}{16}$ vertical stainless steel cables (mill finish) with 1x2 typical posts and 2x2 corner posts painted dark grey as suggested by Community Board 2.


Note: The cornice's original color is dark green though at a distance it appears nearly black.

Picket guardrails set at the roof edge are a common feature in the district.












































VANTAGE POINTS from Jane Street corner
