











1 - Community Bldg. West Elevation and Street-Facing Entrance








2 - Community Bldg. East Elevation and Park-Facing Entrance (from Pool Deck)

















1 - Existing Freestanding Wood Ramp at East Entrance




2 - Proposed Concrete Ramp and Landing at East Entrance





Goals


- Provide ADA access routes to and within Main Building and two Wing Buildings E. Houston St. House and Stanton St. House.
- Repair and replace-in-kind deteriorating portions of exterior components and interior finishes at Main Building and Wing Buildings.
- Restore roof membranes at Main Building and two Wing Buildings.
- Restore existing window frames at Main Building and two Wing Buildings.
- Programmatic reconfiguration of the Main Building.
- Reconstruct Terrace to be water-tight.

















Existing Stainless Steel Handrails

Existing 1-1/4" stainless steel square tube handrails to be removed and replaced with code-compliant handrail.



Replacement Stainless Steel Handrails

Replacement 1-1/2" diameter stainless steel handrails.

Existing 1-1/4" stainless steel square tube guardrails to be removed and replaced with code-compliant guardrail.
