












Existing Cellar Plan




Proposed Cellar Plan




Existing First Floor Plan




Proposed First Floor Plan




Existing Second Floor Plan




Proposed Second Floor Plan




Existing Third Floor Plan




Proposed Third Floor Plan




Existing Fourth Floor Plan








Existing Fifth Floor Plan




Proposed Fifth Floor Plan





Existing Sixth Floor Plan




Proposed Sixth Floor Plan


Existing Roof Plan


