




BACKGROUND


- Constructed in 1882.
- The building was originally designed by McKim Mead and White as a private residence
- In the 1970s, a tower was added to convert the building into a hotel. Tower was
 designed by Emery Roth & Sons. A portion of the building was demolished to
 accommodate the tower.
- There is a history of multiple renovations to the building's courtyard throughout its existence.
 - Original-Grass circle at the center of the courtyard
 - 1940's-Small pavers
 - 1970's- Celtic Knot Pattern
 - 2013-Current scheme under Certificate of Appropriateness 14-6667
