

Goals

- Install a boardwalk to provide an ADA accessible pathway from the parking lot to the front porch and the main east entrance, promoting inclusiveness and use of the house and park by the public.
- Expand and repave the parking lot, including additional ADA parking. The parking lot is partially outside the LPC zone.
- Reconstruct the front lawn steps and restore the front pathway.









Aerial view of the Alice Austen Park from the northeast corner of the lot.

There will be no change to the façade. The proposed ADA accessible boardwalk will run along the side / south façade of the building, screened from view by the existing shrubbery, and connect the parking lot / rear façade to the house's main entrance.

The front steps leading to the front pathway will be reconstructed and regraveled with crushed granite, a stabilizer, to provide an accessible surface.











NYC Parks Alice Austen Park – Proposed ADA Boardwalk Along the South Facade

















































1 NORTH ELEVATION - EXISTING

Scale: 1/4" = 1'-0"


















