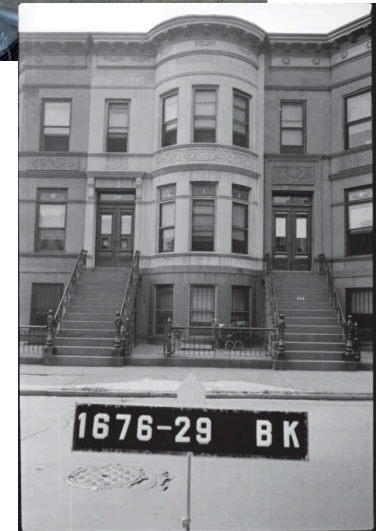
## Scope of Work

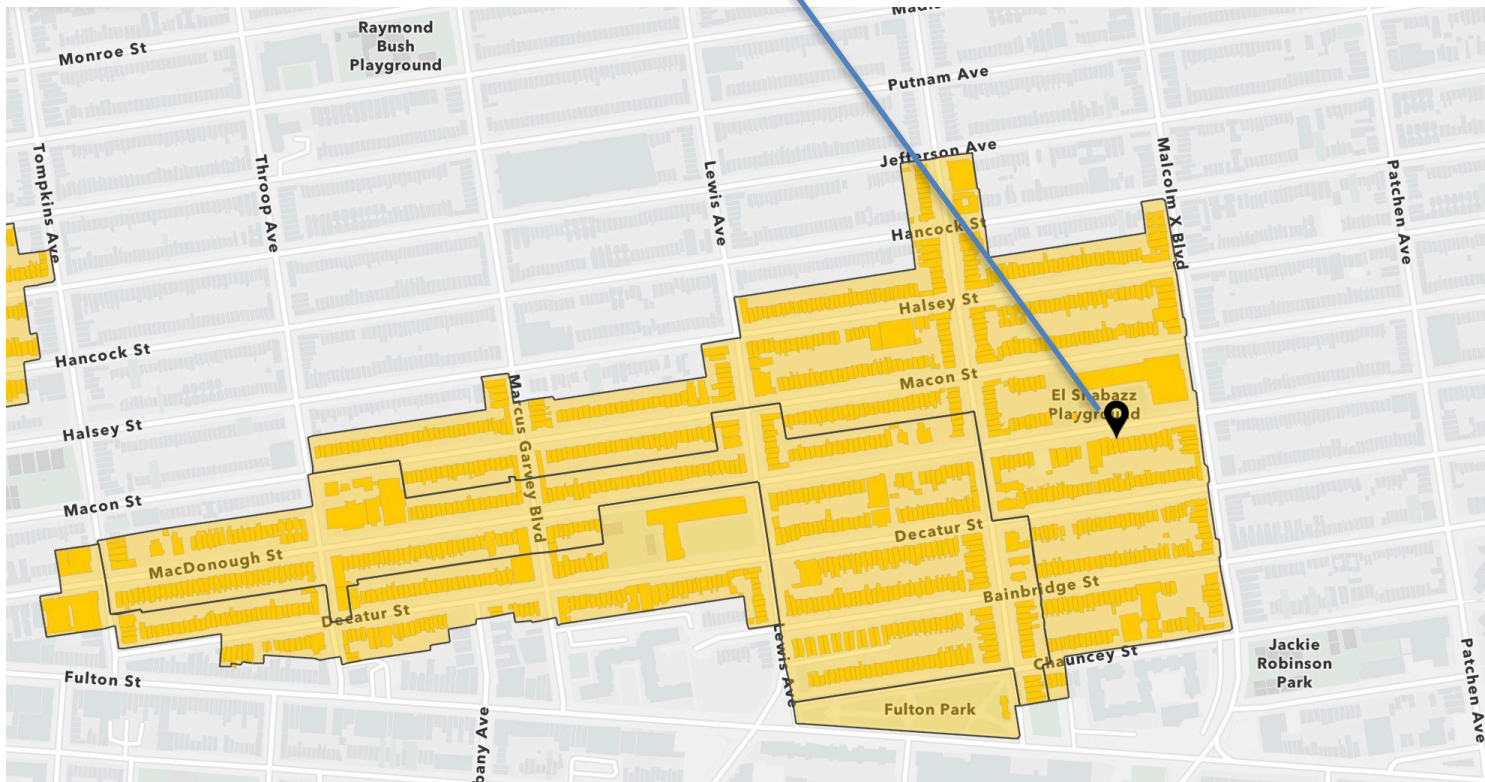

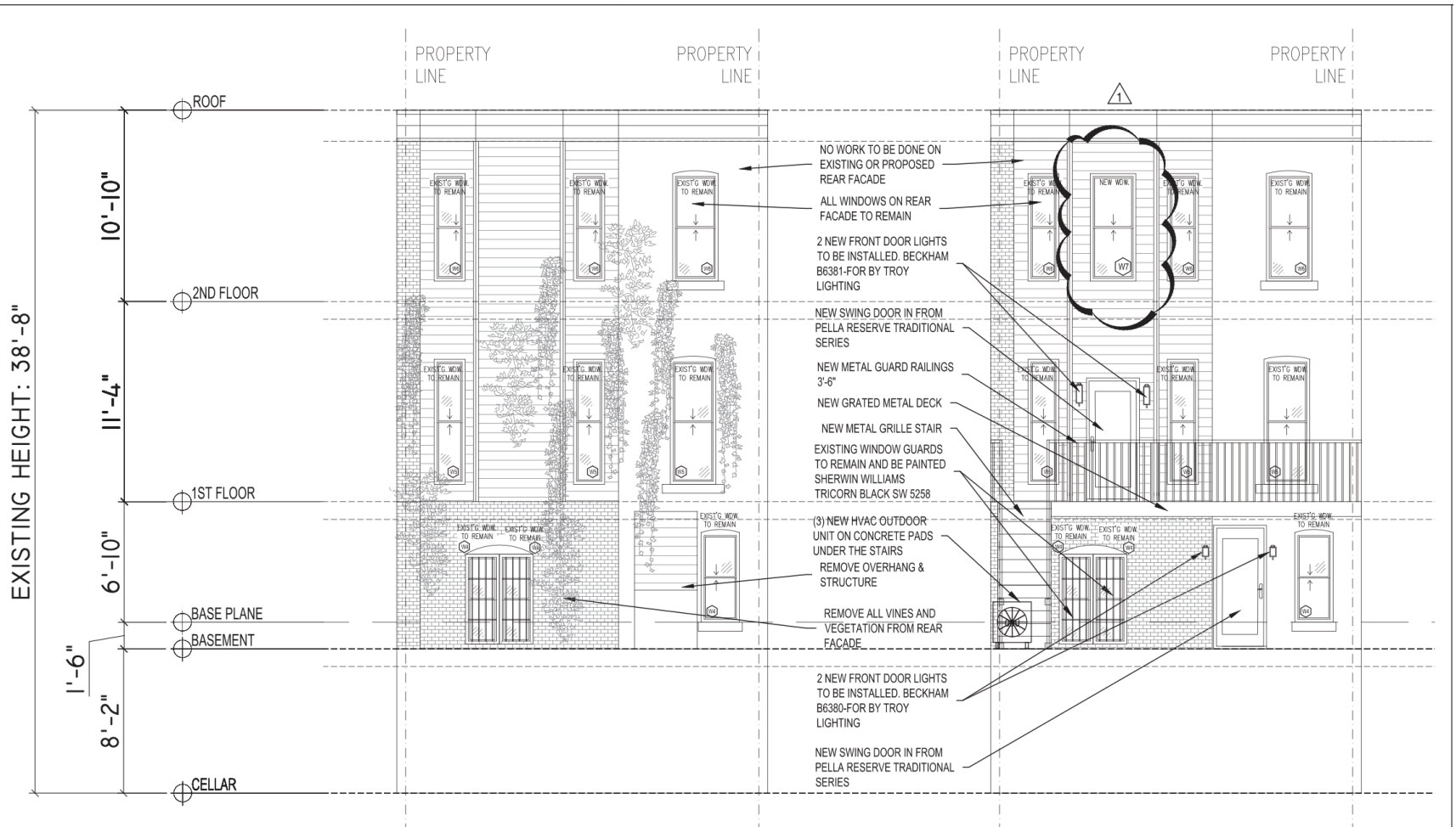

# Rear Elevation

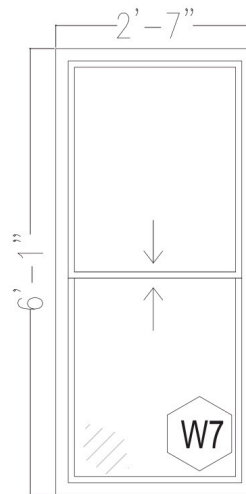

- Panel composition reflects window patterns
- Probe of Modern Siding
- No existing metal cladding

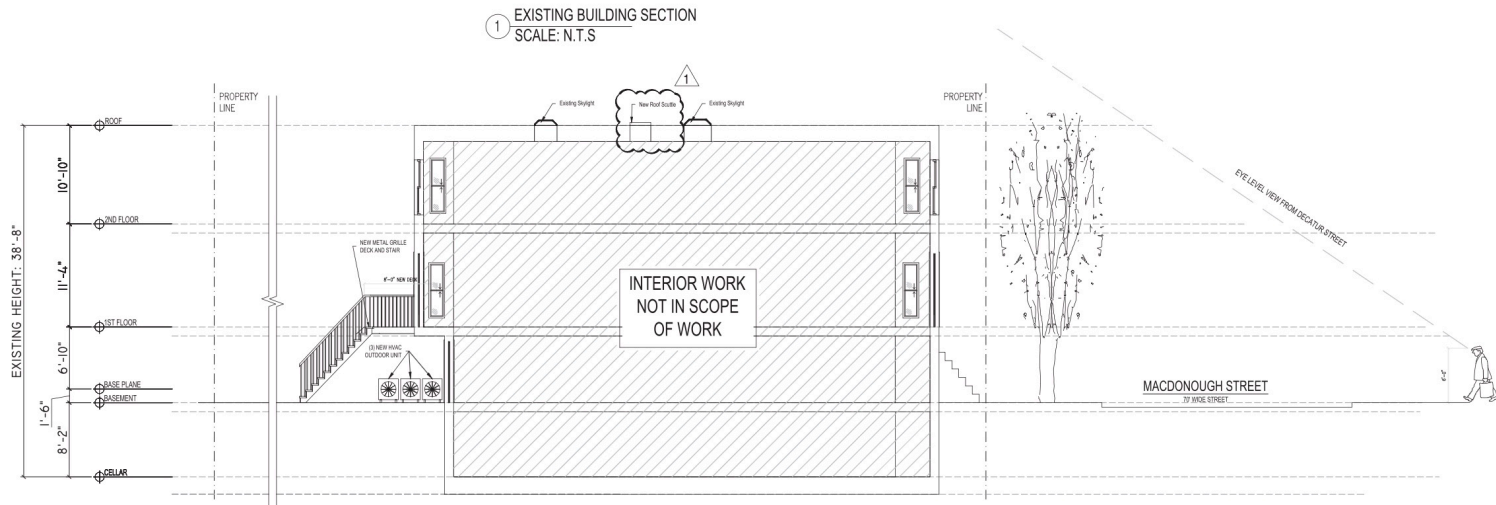
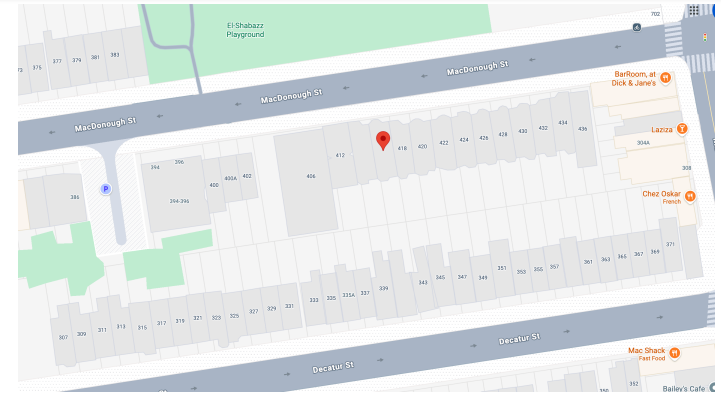

# Visibility

- Located at rear facade
- No visibility from public way
- Work occurs within interior lot condition



## Summary

- Reinforces existing facade composition
- Aligns with established window pattern
- Consistent with neighboring conditions
- No visibility from public way
- No impact on primary facade

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
