#### TRIBECA SOUTH HISTORIC DISTRICT EXTENSION MAP



PROPOSED ONE-STORY VERTICAL ENLARGEMENT OF THE TWO EXISTING FOUR-STORY BUILDINGS AT 112-114 CHAMBERS STREET.

- REMOVAL OF EXISTING STOREFRONT INFILL, AND THE INSTALLATION OF NEW PAINTED WOOD AND GLASS STOREFRONT INFILL (BEHR CRACKED PEPPER), WITH PANELED BULKHEADS AND TRANSOMS;
- REMOVAL OF EXISTING FIRE ESCAPES;
- REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING HISTORIC FRONT WOOD WINDOWS TO MATCH ORIGINAL;
- REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING REAR WINDOWS WITH DOUBLE HUNG ALUMINUM WINDOWS;











Dubai is set to become the first place in the world to offer travelers flights on air taxis after its transport authority agreed a deal with eVTOL aircraft maker Joby and vertiport provider Skyports Infrastructure.

An agreement between Dubai's Road and Transport Authority (RTA), Skyports and Joby gives the former exclusive rights to build and operate vertiports in Dubai, and the latter the exclusive right to operate air taxis in Dubai for six years.

This will provide Skyport & Joby with experience in advance of eVTOL flight at Pier 6
