Since soil excavation and truck loading activities are scheduled to resume on Thursday but NYSDEC is not planning to be onsite, we are considering making another site visit on Thursday to verify field operations are in compliance with the RAWP and to verify air quality in the areas surrounding the Site on all four sides (across the street and along the exterior of the fence) and at the air intakes for Southbridge Towers. As we have been doing, air quality monitoring would be a few inches above the ground, at the child's breathing height (approx.3 feet from the ground) and at the adult's breathing level (approx. 5 feet from the ground).
