#### Timeline

- March 2018 CB 3 Meeting: Parks met with Manhattan CB 3 to present the Request for Expression of Interest ("RFEI") for the Bathhouse Site at Baruch Playground
- November 2018 RFEI Issued: For the "repurpose of the bathhouse building site and surrounding area for a parks and/or non-parks use located at the Baruch Playground, Manhattan"
  - Two responses were received
- Winter 2018 Fall 2019: Parks hosted four Community Task Force meetings to discuss RFEI responses and the scope of an upcoming RFP



#### Timeline cont.

- December 2019 CB 3 Meeting: Parks returned to discuss the RFEI responses and upcoming RFP
- September 2020 RFP Released: For the Development, Operation and Maintenance of a Community Sports and Programming Facility (20-year term); two proposals received
- November 2023 CB 3 Meeting: Parks presented plans from highest-rated proposer and potential award; unfortunately, this proposer was not able to secure the funding envisioned for the project
- July 2024 CB 3 Resolution: The CB asked Parks to reissue an RFEI
- January 2025: RFEI released
- March 2025: RFEI proposal received
- May 2025: Parks met with RFEI respondents

#### **Brief Recap of RFEI**


- The area outlined in red represents the footprint of the bathhouse structure.

#### Proposal


- Year-round padel facility open daily with affordable court time, high-quality amenities, and programming for all skill levels
  - 7 padel courts
  - 2 pickleball courts
  - Outdoor gym





#### Proposal Cont.

- Demolition of the Baruch Bathhouse\*\*\*
  - Introduction of event space in the bathhouse location
  - Amphitheater seating for community gatherings and events
- Pro Shop with lockers, bathrooms (more than double overall capacity on site), and a juice bar
- "Air Dome" will be added to allow for year-long enjoyment of facilities







#### Proposal Cont.

- Reduced rates available
- "Padel for all" initiative with monthly free introductory classes for NYCHA residents
- Free court time for Baruch houses residents during off-peak hours

- Padel clinics and camps for children during school breaks and weekends
- Opportunities for students to become ambassadors and event organizers
- Offer volunteer-led events or charity tournaments
