Dear Ms. Stetzer,

The New York City Department of Transportation (NYC DOT) is planning to implement a two-way protected bicycle lane on Chatham Square between East Broadway and Worth Street/Park Row. This improvement builds upon the recently completed improvements on Park Row creating a two-way bike path between Pearl Street and Worth Street.

Attached is a diagram of the proposed improvements. These improvements include the following:

- 1. New green two-way bike path adjacent to Kimlau Square on the east curb of Chatham Square.
- 2. Jersey barriers lining the bike path between East Broadway and Worth Street.
- 3. Revised signal timing at Park Row and Worth Street to appropriately accommodate the bicyclists.

Chatham Square falls within a Vision Zero priority area, these improvements will create a safe, direct connection for bicyclists and improve safety for all roadway users. 
