

“DEP would like to request a street renaming in memory of two longtime Manhattan DEP employees, the late **Salvatore and Eric Dellecave (father and son)**, who led our Field Operations out of Pike St. for decades. Sal started at DEP in the late 1960’s, retiring in 2008. Eric’s service started in 1995 through the day he tragically succumbed to a heart attack in 2021.

Both Sal and Eric were on duty out of Pike on the morning of September 11th and assisted FDNY with hydrants and water supply. Pike Street, as you know, was a major staging area and command post (one of many) for multi agencies who responded to the attacks and recovery efforts. DEP respectfully requests your support in renaming Pike Street, between Henry and Madison in honor of Sal and Eric Dellecave, recognizing their family’s 40 plus year legacy of service and dedication to the water and sewer infrastructure of Manhattan.”
