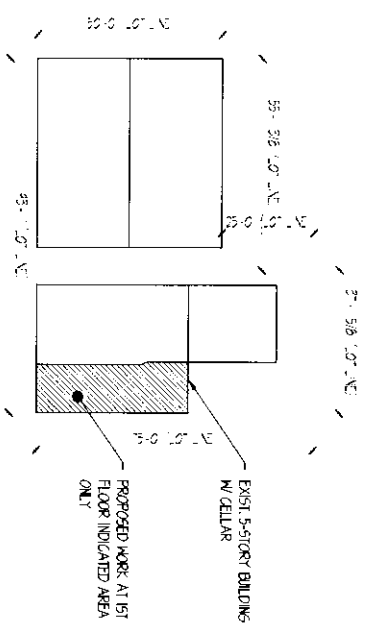






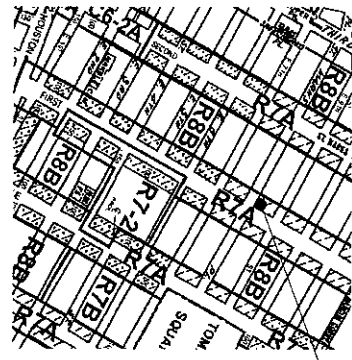


ST MARK'S PL



SITE PLAN

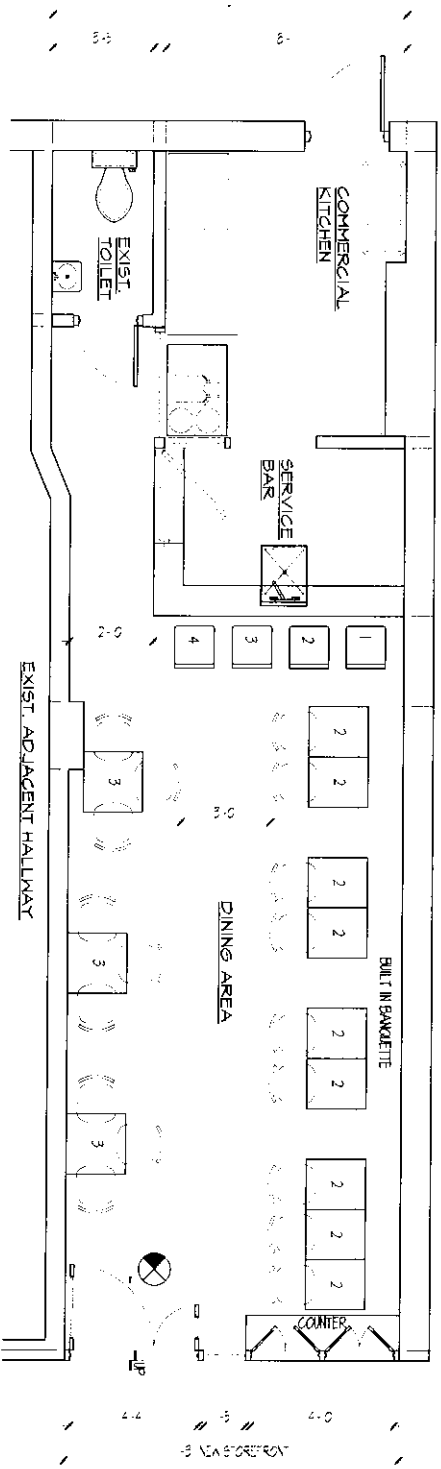
