

U.S. Will Try To Open Phone Without Apple

New Plan for the F.B.I.; Hearing Is Put Off

RIVERSIDE, Calif. — The Justice Department said on Monday that it might no longer need Apple's assistance in opening an iPhone used by a gunman in the San Bernardino, Calif., rampage last year, leading to a postponement of a court hearing over the issue and temporarily sidestepping what has become a bitter clash with the world's most valu-

In a new court filing, the government said that as of Sunday, an outside party had demonstrated a way for the F.B.I. to possibly unlock the phone used by Syed Rizwan Farook, one of the San Bernardino attackers. The hearing in the contentious case — Apple has loudly opposed opening the iPhone, citing privacy conoriginally set for Tuesday.

"Testing is required to determine whether it is a viable method Farook's iPhone," the Justice Department wrote in the filing. "If the method is viable, it should eliminate the need for the assistance from Apple." The Justice Department added that it would file a status report by April 5 on its progress on unlocking the iPhone. Late on Monday, Judge Sheri N. 
