Federal Shutdown Seen as Likely

WASHINGTON—Lawmak-ers braced for the federal gov-ernment to begin shutting down early Saturday morning, as a one-month spending bill headed toward an expected collapse in a late-night Senate vote.

Facing opposition from most Senate Democrats and some Republicans, the short-term spending bill passed by the House was expected to come short of the 60 votes needed to clear the Senate. With no fallback plan, lawmakers said they were anticipating a shutdown, which would fall on the first anniversary of President Donald Trump's in-

President Donald Trump's in-auguration.
"I think it is almost 100% likely the government will shut down for some period of time," Rep. John Yarmuth (D., Ky.) said as he left a meeting of other House Democrats.
"Everything we see indicates there's no ways to avoid as hetthere's no way to avoid a shut-down."
