## Soda Club NYC LLC – 155 Avenue B CB3 Questionnaire Supplement

#### Crowd Management

Guests will be greeted upon entry by the host who will seat them at an appropriate table. If a table is not available, the host will take down the name and call back number to notify the guests when their table is available. The host will also suggest a local neighboring establishment to visit while waiting so as to keep the sidewalk clear.

#### Noise Control

The establishment will have sound proofing installed to ensure neighbors will not hear any noise. The host on duty will direct customers out from in front of the establishment, whether that is while entering or exiting the establishment or while being placed on a wait list. No crowds will be allowed in front of the building.

Has any principal had work experience similar to the proposed business?

Ravi's bars and restaurants have been featured in hundreds of thousands of national, international and local publications, received acclaim for their impact on cocktail culture and two of his establishments have published cocktail books. Named one of Wine Enthusiast's Tastemakers of the year, it is no doubt that he is the man behind several of New York City's favorite bars.

Having achieved a level of notoriety and success in the cocktail world, Ravi shifted his focus to food where his innovation was noticed by the New York Times, Forbes, Zagat and The New Yorker. A vegetarian-turned-vegan himself, Ravi holds a deep affection for all animals, and has been an outspoken voice on animal rights issues. His nonprofit BEAST Foundation and shift to plant-based ventures has warranted both local and national applause, receiving an award from PETA for his efforts.

I have attached below the proper way to insulate a room, which Derossi and Co. have agreed to.

### Soundproofing specs

Remove existing:

gypsum board

mineral wool (Roxul) insulation

metal framing that supported ceiling. Demo but save mineral wool insulation for re-use.

Inform owner that ceiling has been removed.

At owner's expense owner will remove steam pipes and patch holes in first floor floor and second floor ceiling, and modify any other building mechanical systems that owner decides need to be moved or removed.

Apply foam insulation to underside of first floor ceiling. 4 inch minimum. (Closed or Open cell foam TBD)

Install or improve venting for bathroom and kitchen (quiet Panasonic fan for bathroom? (After new ceiling is in... mount fans on kitchen ceiling for reducing noise and for future maintenance without opening ceiling and destroying soundproofing.)

Secure strips of  $\frac{3}{4}$  x 6 inch plywood (won't split like real wood), on brick walls with Hilti nails or equivalent, X" below joists.

Plywood to run East and West with factory-cut edge on the bottom, with a ¾" diameter bead of acoustic caulk placed between the wood and the brick, wood to be installed within 20 minutes of applying acoustic caulk.

After installing wood install a second ¾" bead of acoustic caulk where the top edge of the wood meets the brick wall.

Use metal joist hangers sized for 2" x 6" wood running North and South on plywood for ceiling framing.

Mount any desired ceiling electrical boxes on framing, mount any desired recessed ceiling lighting fixtures on framing. Recessed ceiling lighting fixtures to be airtight type, rated for contact with insulation. Install all wires that will connect to ceiling electrical boxes or recessed ceiling lighting fixtures or security system or music system or any other system.

Air tighten all holes in electric boxes and recessed ceiling lighting fixtures (holes for connecting wires) with water based duct mastic.

Air tighten the surface of all BX (Greenfield) cables for 6" away from electric boxes.

Air tighten all joints in all ducts with water based duct mastic.

Install any ceiling mounted or above-ceiling components of any cooling system or other objects to be installed on the premises. Inform owner the above work is completed and ready for inspection by owner.

After obtaining approval from owner, install a Y" thick layer of mineral wool insulation on top of the wood ceiling framing, using old insulation if desired and buying new mineral wool insulation as necessary.

Install sound board (brand? Type? Thickness?)

Then install a layer of 5/8" thick (sound resistant) gypsum board insulation on the ceiling, with a ½" diameter bead of acoustic caulk in the 3-way joint between the gypsum board and the brick wall and the plywood, and a bead of acoustic caulk connecting the gypsum board to any ceiling electric boxes and ceiling recessed lighting fixtures.

Tape all joints between pieces of gypsum board ceiling.

- Acoustic caulk.
- Airtight ceiling lighting fixtures (should be airtight and rated for contact with insulation.
- Water based duct mastic.






