RE: LICENSE ALTERATION

Licensee is seeking to offer all manner of legally allowable non-scheduled, no cover fee entertainment including but not limited to karaoke, live stage performance, DJ, bingo, jazz trio's, dance performance, drag performance, spoken word, drama, comedy, etc. In addition, Licensee is seeking to change operating hour to Noon to 4am, 7 days.

There is currently a legally filed, built, and approved stage which has been in the space for more than 15 years and was used for live performances for over 10 years in this manner by James Carbone, principal of current licensee, Performance area is in full compliance with all local requirements and is on the approved Building Department Approved Plans.

This Application is done in anticipation of lower than expected revenues due to the Covid-19 crisis and its' resultant consequences. Licensee will need to create additional different sources of revenue in order to meet the financial obligations of the premises including maintaining employees, paying all state and local taxes as well as the underlying financial commitments of the enterprise. The more entertainment offerings availed to the Applicant, the more likely the event the Applicant will survive the current economic carnage.

In addition Applicant currently does not have use of the street area for Outdoor Dining as there is an issue as to which tenant has the sidewalk frontage, the Applicant or the Bar above. NY City has issued the permit to Applicant but currently the tenant above has seen fit to place their seats directly in front of Applicants' entrance and stairs. Applicant has asked the Landlord to mediate this issue.

The unique layout and location of the license premises provides for more than adequate soundproofing and crowd control given that the performance stage is located in the cellar level underneath two existing bars. In addition the premises are fully soundproofed and there are multiple exits and entrances to insure proper crowd control and exterior mitigation.
