Dear Community Board #3:

We are the Board of a 75-unit cooperative at a 1920's 17-story building on 11th Street and Second Avenue. Our residents are a representative mix of the population of the East Village: residents who have lived here for decades and raised families here (including families where multiple generations now live in the building), more recent neighbors with young families, renters, and an overall mix of generations, professions and backgrounds. We have a total of 3 commercial spaces: aside from the space referenced herein, there is a pharmacy and an eyeglass store - and we have worked hard with our commercial tenants during the pandemic in an effort to aid in their survival. We all care deeply about the East Village community and our quality of life here.

We met with Rakesh Chandiramani, the new leaseholder of the corner retail space, on multiple occasions. He has provided us with an overview of the Vin Sur Vignt Wine Bar concept that he intends to open. He answered all our questions and addressed any concerns. We appreciate his outreach to our Board and are satisfied that we are starting off on the right foot with his company. We have also spoken with references in other buildings where he leases Vin Sur Vignt locations and were told they are good tenants with no issues or complaints, quality of life or otherwise. We look forward to a long-term relationship with Vin Sur Vignt and wish Rakesh much success with his new location.

Representing the unanimous support of the Board of Directors, it is my pleasure to express our enthusiastic support for VSV Wine Bar's application for a license to serve beer and wine (no hard liquor) with light recorded background music (no loud music, live music or DJs), with closing hours no later than 12am on Sunday and Monday's and Tuesday through Saturday, no later than 2am.
