Lullaby

Lullaby provides a dressed-down, yet high-caliber cocktail experience. The goal of this project is to bring a level of accessibility to a quality drinking experience that forgoes the frills and pretenses of the modern cocktail bar. This will be a place where *anyone* can relax, socialize, and enjoy an excellent drink without feeling intimidated, ignorant, or as though they are *required* to participate in "cocktail culture." Lullaby believes that an experience centered around the establishment rather than the guest is detrimental to the concept of hospitality. Therefore, Lullaby will balance an elevated drinking experience with an unassuming atmosphere and style of service, centered around the humble reason we drink: to relax and have fun.


Brother Cleve
