Plans to manage vehicular traffic and crowds on the sidewalk

I plan to operate an establishment that will not negatively impact our neighbors. I am an experienced operator who has worked very hard to earn my reputation as a committed community partner and am confident this will be an establishment that CB3 will be proud to call its own.

I do not anticipate large crowds on the street. I will ensure that the premises are maintained in an orderly fashion at all times. I will designate an employee to make sure that a crowd of patrons will not form in front of or adjacent to my establishment as I do not want to disturb the quality of life of my fellow neighbors.

I will have signs visibly posted inside and on the storefront reminding patrons to be courteous of the neighborhood and to keep noise to a minimum. However, should a crowd form in front of or adjacent to our establishment, I will immediately inform the crowd that they are not able to congregate in front of the establishment.

I understand that parking is limited in the area. I anticipate that the overwhelming majority of my patrons will be walking; I plan to serve a community that lives and works in the immediate vicinity.

Plans to manage noise inside and outside of the premises

I plan to install soundproofing at my establishment so that the conversations of patrons and music will not emanate to the residential apartments surrounding my establishment. My plans are not to run a nightclub establishment but rather a friendly neighborhood establishment. The entertainment to be provided will be for quality and not for volume with a set compressor limiter for a predetermined sound level that will be tested inside the residential units above and outside of the establishment. A sound level control instrument will be placed inside of the establishment as a warning to the staff should the noise become too loud. The cell number of myself as well as the manager I hire will also be given to the residents of the building should they feel the need to call immediately if any noise is disturbing their quality of life. I plan on keeping any noise to a minimum.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN EAST 4th STREET/LOWER AVENUE B BLOCK ASSOCIATION AND Gama Lounge LLC

Joseph Batista	, of Gama Lounge LLC, hereby agrees to abide by the
following stipulations:	

- 1. It will operate as a café and lounge with a kitchen open and serving food all hours.
- It's hours of operation will be 9:00 AM to 12:00 AM Sunday to Wednesday and 9:00 AM to 1:00 AM Thursday to Saturday.
- 3. It will play ambient, recorded background music and may have live acoustic music at background level in the lower level only;
- 4. It will close any doors and or windows at 10:00 PM every night or when live music or loud events take place.
- 5. It will install soundproofing to ensure that sound and bass from the business will be inaudible in neighboring apartments. If necessary, will consult with a sound engineer and install soundproofing consistent with their recommendations to ensure that sound is inaudible in neighboring apartments.
- 6. It will ensure that any equipment in the airshaft or on the roof is properly soundproofed as not to disturb the neighboring apartments.
- 7. It will only have outdoor dining as permissible during the ongoing COVID state of emergency until 10:00 P.M. all days. After the state of emergency, it will not commercially use any outdoor space, including filing for a sidewalk café permit without coming to the Block association and the Community board first.
- 8. It will not host any pub crawls, party buses, djs, promoted events, any event in which a cover is charged or scheduled performances.
- 9. It will not offer unlimited drink specials.
- 10. It will not have "Boozy Brunches".
- 11. It will not offer discounts, promotions or specials on shots or offer large format alcoholic beverages (drink towers, party bowls, etc.).
- 12. It will have happy hours that end by 8:00 PM.
- 13. It will not have wait lines.
- 14. It will research how best to arrange trash pick-up in a manner least disturbing and disruptive to community residents and will work with other nearby restaurant and bar owners to coordinate a common trash pickup at hours least disturbing and disruptive to community residents.
- 15. It will designate a staff person to monitor the sidewalk and ensure there are no crowds, noise or loitering.
- 16. It will provide staff with supervisory authority on premises during all hours.
- 17. It will provide a telephone number for residents to call with complaints and immediately address any resident complaints.
