I strongly urge you to approve the application.



WASHINGTON, March 8 — Joe Biden on Monday announced that the United States would ban imports of Russian oil, a move that would significantly reduce the flow of Russian energy into the United States and its allies.

The ban, which takes effect immediately, covers all Russian oil imports from the United States, as well as from other countries that are transshipping Russian oil. It also covers Russian oil that is refined in the United States.

The move is part of a broader effort by the Biden administration to pressure Russia to end its invasion of Ukraine. It is the first time that the United States has banned imports of Russian oil.
