Acoustical Analysis Report / Re: Gonzos Rehearsal Space

Hush Soundproofing has completed an interior acoustic survey and analysis for renovations for Gonzo's music rehearsal space renovations located on the 3rd and 4th floor of 6 Saint Marks Place in New York, NY.

These recommendations are based on our visit May 9, 2022, documentation and conversations with the Architect at Eco Plus Design Inc.

We were able to determine the existing wall structure to be:

5/8" Sheetrock affixed to 25 Gauge 2x3 steel framing over the existing brick wall, no insulation.

Noise Rating for these materials is STC 25

For live music rehearsal, we recommend a STC 50+ wall construction, this type of noise reduction incorporates multiple soundproofing techniques

Absorption: Using Insulation or open cell foam to absorb resonating frequencies within a cavity. Installing Acoustic paneling within a source room to absorb sound and reduce the overall volume reflecting within the room.

Damping: Use of Mass Loaded Vinyl or Viscoelastic Compound to damp vibration of a surface such as a wall, Ceiling or floor

Decoupling: separating the existing wall from the new wall construction so vibration cannot travel. Using Resilient Isolation Clips or Double Studded walls.

Distance: creating an air-gap, which weakens sound pressure of the source sound, over distance sound weakens. A wall with a larger air-gap will have higher STC rating.

Mass: This refers to the thickness and density of a material. Mass stops sound. Example are, Wood, Cement, Sheetrock, Mass Loaded Vinyl, Sand... In soundproofing, we use multiple layers of different materials with different densities to reduce a variance in frequency.

Ratings and Measurements for Acoustics

NRC (Noise Reduction Coefficient): The amount of sound a material can absorb STC (Sound Transmission Class): The Amount of Sound being reduced by a composite of soundproofing materials and techniques

This solution is a STC 75 wall construction for each room, Walls where the buildings attach will have an additional barrier STC 60.

The shaft between buildings will not transfer vibration. Even So, we will treat this potion of the walls the same way we are treating the attached portion.

- 1 layers 3/4" CDX Plywood (Fire Retardant) against existing brick wall
- 1 layer Mass Loaded Vinyl
- 1 layers 5/8" Cement Board
- 1 layers Mass Loaded Vinyl
- 1 layers 5/8" Cement Board

New 1 5/8" Steel Framing (decoupled from existing wall)

- 1 layer Rockwool SafenSound
- 1 layers 5/8" sheetrock
- 1 layer of MLV
- 1 layers 5/8" sheetrock
- 1 layer of MLV
- 1 layers 5/8" sheetrock

Seal All cracks and gaps with spray foam and Acoustical Caulk




